marks NSA used prior to the litigation as indicia of the Baha'i Faith, have become incontestable. True and accurate copies of NSA's United States Patent and Trademark Office certified status copies of such registrations are attached as Wilson Exhibit 1.

6. I have conducted an online search of the United States Patent and Trademark Office's principal trademark registry for trademark registrations of marks containing the word BAHA'I. The results of my investigation indicate that NSA's five federal registrations containing the word BAHA'I are the only federal registrations containing the word BAHA'I on the United States Patent and Trademark Office's principal trademark registry.

7. The Baha'i Faith has no denominations whatsoever. There is the Baha'i Faith, on the one hand, and on the other hand there are former followers of Mason Remey, removed from the Baha'i Faith, and their successors, such as the Marangella group and SIBC.

8. The 1966 Judgment determined that there is one Baha'i Faith and that those who followed Mason Remey in the 1960s were not the Baha'i Faith. See Memorandum for Rule at Exhibit 1 (Findings of Fact at ¶ 6; Conclusions of Law at ¶¶ 12-13).

9. I have investigated the remaining so-called "organizations." "Bahais Under the Living Guardianship" referred to in Mr. Goldberg's Declaration does not appear to have any organization at all. The only evidence of record regarding this supposed entity is the www.guardianshipofthebahaifaith.org domain name. The Web site at this domain claims that Donald Harvey, now deceased, and Jacques Sogohmonian are "continuing" Guardians. The record indicates, however, that both Donald Harvey and Jacques Sogohmonian joined Joel Marangella in supporting Mason Remey in 1960 and that Donald

Harvey was a member of Remey's Second International Baha'i Council under Marangella's presidency of that institution. Wilson Exhibit 2. Accordingly, this Web site does not evidence a denomination of the Baha'i Faith, instead, if anything, it evidences a split among those who believe Mason Remey was a guardian.

10. The attached Declaration of Tracey L. Giertz indicates that the Web site at www.guardianshipofthebahaifaith.org is registered to Brent Mathieu. See NSA Reply at Exhibit 2, ¶¶ 14. My research indicates that Brent Mathieu was connected to Leland and Opal Jensen in Missoula, Montana in 1973 and recognized Mason Remey as "guardian" prior to Mason Remey's death in 1974.

11. The only other person I have identified having involvement with this Web site is an individual named Brent Reed. Brent Reed was formerly a member of the Marangella group. Wilson Exhibit 3.

12. I have also investigated the purported "organization" of John Carre. There is no discernable organization, only Web postings attributed to Mr. Carre at www.metavergance.com/john/. The record indicates that Mr. Carre is a contemporary of Joel Marangella who supported Mason Remey's claims. Wilson Exhibit 4. Again, if it evidences anything this Web address indicates a split among those who believe that Mason Remey was a guardian.

13. I have visited the Web sites at domain names <http://freebahais.com/freebahai.htm> and <http://members.tripod.com/ninetin/abdulbaha/contents.htm>. The freebahais.com Web site does not indicate that there is any organization associated with it. The attached Affidavit of Tracey Giertz, indicates that this domain name did not have content associated with it

until February 7, 2006. See Reply Brief at Exhibit 2, ¶ 15. The Web page at <http://members.tripod.com/ninetin/abdulbaha/contents.htm>, purported to be evidence of a “Unitarian” Baha’i group, in the Declaration of Jeffrey Goldberg, simply reads “The Secret Acts of Abdul Baha” and does not indicate that any organization is associated with it. Whatever this Web site is intended to convey is incomprehensible.

14. The Web site at “reformbahai.org” is the site of an outspoken critic of NSA named Frederick Glaysher. While the Web site gives the impression that an organization is associated with Mr. Glaysher, there is no such organization. On information and belief, Mr. Glaysher’s claims are simply not taken seriously by any one. The Web site is merely a stage, in a corner of the Web, for Mr. Glaysher’s unusual fixation upon, and animus toward, NSA. This, of course, is not evidence of a Baha’i Faith denomination. The attached affidavit of Tracey Giertz indicates there was no content at this site until September 3, 2004. *See id.* at ¶ 18.

15. Mr. Schlatter also asserts that there is a “regency” organization formed by Rex King, a former member of the Remey Corporation and Marangella group. Rex King died in 1977 and *Mason Remey and Those Who Followed Him* noted that he left “whatever rights he believed he had” to his familial descendents. *See Schlatter Declaration at Exhibit 9.* There is no indication that any present-day adherents to his claims exist. In any event, Rex King was an officer in the Remey Corporation and discovery revealed that he was a member of the Marangella group.

16. Accordingly, there is no evidence of any Baha’i Faith denominations. On the contrary, the evidence is that the divisions existed between those who believe Mason Remey was a guardian.

17. The Remeyites' resort to Web searches for "evidence" of organizations allegedly constituting Baha'i Faith denominations is revealing of the fact that no such organizations exist outside the Web page musings of a few misinformed people in a corner of the Internet.

18. As General Counsel, my responsibilities include the protection of NSA's intellectual property rights. If the activities of the alleged contemnors' unauthorized use of the trademarks had been anything but *de minimus*, the matter would have been brought to my attention.

19. The article *Mason Remey and Those Who Followed Him*, at Exhibit 9 to Mr. Schlatter's Declaration, provides an accurate snap-shot of the situation as of 1997. The Remeyites had completely disbanded, passed away, or otherwise faded into complete obscurity. This indicates that the measures taken by NSA were effective and, therefore, its forbearance from bringing suit was reasonable. It was not until the Web that the alleged contemnors attempted to draw any attention to themselves.

20. The Baha'i Faith engages in work of significance for humanity worldwide. See Declaration of Geoffrey N. Wilson In Support of NSA's Motion For A Rule To Show Cause at ¶¶ 15-19, 22, 23, 26. The activities of the alleged contemnors were remote, localized in rural New Mexico and Montana, and exceedingly small in scale. NSA had no basis for pursuing action until relatively recently, when circumstances changed and the alleged contemnors began seeking to raise their profile via the Internet. Once the NSA became aware of these new activities it objected.

21. NSA educated its members of the dangers people such as Remeyites posed, in an attempt to prevent confusion. This approach has been effective. The Marangella

group admits as much. *See* NSA Reply To PNBC'S Response at Exhibits 19, pp. 103-104 and 54.

22. It was not until easy access to the Web, that the alleged contemnors were able to attempt to reach an audience, give the false impression that they are substantial organizations, maintain a permanent "address" for visitors and easily converse with Internet users, all under cover of NSA's marks. When NSA became aware of this development, and these infringing uses of NSA's marks on the Web did not abate, NSA took action.

23. I first became aware of SIBC's activities on the Web in August of 2003, in connection with its www.uhj.net Web site. NSA began its enforcement by preparing and filing a UDRP complaint with ICANN for the transfer of the www.uhj.net domain name. The UDRP complaint was filed on February 24, 2005, but did not result in transfer of the domain name. SIBC's response to the ICANN complaint provided substantial information regarding its connections with the entities enjoined by the 1966 Judgment, leading NSA to name SIBC in this proceeding.

24. I first became aware of PNBC's Web site at <http://www.rt66.com/~obfusa/council.htm> sometime in Spring of 2006. Likewise, I first became aware of the Web sites at bahai-guardian.com and truebahai.com in sometime in Spring of 2006.

25. The attached affidavit of Tracey L. Giertz indicates that the www.uhj.net Web site first had relevant content on November 28, 2002 and www.bupc.org first had relevant content on November 11, 1998, then was offline from at least October 2, 2000

through October 21, 2003, when relevant content appeared again. See NSA Reply Brief, Exhibit 2 at ¶¶ 2-6.

26. Paragraph 39 of Mr. Schlatter's declaration refers to a dispute involving a Yahoo! listing in 1997. I was in my current position with NSA in 1997. Had NSA been aware of the issue it would have been my responsibility to handle it. I have never heard of this matter and NSA was not involved.

27. Mr. Schlatter's declaration confirms the localized and sporadic nature of the Marangella group's activities. The small advertisements he described appear to be placed very sporadically and in the classified pages of a few publications.

28. Moreover, *Mason Remey and Those Who Followed Him*, at Exhibit 9 to Schlatter's declaration is evidence that NSA took measures to educate its members about the sporadic advertisements that were placed. As Marangella admits, NSA's approach was effective and the placement of advertisements was a failure.

29. Marilyn Meyer's declaration at Paragraph 7, indicates that PNBC had not been served as of January 2, 2007. While NSA disagrees, to put the issue to rest it affected personal service on March 19, 2007 when one of its attorney personally served PNBC at the Meyers' residence in New Mexico as sworn in the attached affidavit of service. Wilson Exhibit 8.

30. NSA was disturbed to learn, through discovery in this case, that the Marangella group has also begun to violate NSA's copyrights in the works of Shoghi Effendi. NSA owns the copyrights for Shoghi Effendi's works, including *The Dispensation of Bahauallah* and the works are published by NSA's Baha'i Publishing Trust.

31. SIBC testified under oath in this proceeding that it was unaware of evidence of confusion regarding its use of the marks. *See* NSA Reply To SIBC's Response.

Attached hereto are true and accurate copies of electronic mail messages evidencing actual confusion created by SIBC's uhj.net Web site. SIBC was aware of these materials at the time of its deposition in this proceeding because the email messages were included with an ICANN complaint served upon SIBC by NSA in 2005. True and accurate copies of these electronic mails, redacted for privacy issues, are attached hereto as Wilson Exhibit 5.

32. Prior to depositions being taken in this case, Franklin Schlatter and PNBC submitted responses to written requests to admit and interrogatories. The responses admitted to many of NSA's allegations. The referenced admissions are attached hereto as Wilson Exhibit 6.

33. The original counterclaimant in this case was identified as National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of the United States of America, Inc. (See June 28, 1966, Opinion). However, this identification came from the pleading filed originally by the counter-defendant in 1964, and was erroneous. The National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of the United States was an "unincorporated voluntary religious association comprised of nine individual members" ("NSA 1"). (See June 28, 1966, Opinion, ¶ 3).

34. On October 14, 1994, NSA1 incorporated under the laws of Illinois as a not for profit corporation to form the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of the United States ("NSA"). Wilson Exhibit 7 at NSA 0005 – 0008. In its incorporation documents, the NSA stated that it is the "successor organization" to NSA1. See *id.* at NSA 0007. All the trustees of NSA 1 were the incorporators of NSA and became directors of NSA. See


id. One of the incorporators, Mr. Firuz Kazemzadeh, was Chairman of NSA1, when it was sued by the counter-defendant in 1964.

35. It was the intent of the trustees of NSA1 to “transfer all powers, rights, responsibilities, privileges, obligations, assets and liabilities” to NSA. See *id.* at 0007. For example, NSA1 was the owner of the trademarks, which are now owned by NSA. See June 28, 1966, Order, ¶19; Declaration of Geoffrey N. Wilson In Support of NSA’s Motion For Rule at ¶28. Like NSA1, NSA is authorized by the Universal House of Justice in Haifa, Israel, as the sole authority of the Baha’i Faith in the United States, entitled to use of the trademarks and service marks of the Baha’i Faith. NSA’s charge is identical to that of NSA1, to supervise, stimulate and unify the activities of the members of the Baha’i Faith in the United States. Among other things, NSA oversees the various Local Spiritual Assemblies as NSA1 had done. (See June 28, 1966, Order, ¶11; Declaration of Geoffrey N. Wilson In Support of NSA’s Motion For Rule at ¶14 & 15). Both NSA1 and its successor NSA, have operated the Baha’i Publishing Trust which disseminates millions of copies of publications concerning the Baha’i Faith. (See June 28, 1966, Order, ¶14; Wilson Dec., ¶17). Like NSA1, NSA is based in Wilmette, Illinois, in the vicinity of the Baha’i House of Worship and NSA maintains the House of Worship, as NSA1 had done. (See June 28, 1966, Order, ¶3, 14 & 15; Wilson Dec. ¶14).

36. When NSA succeeded NSA1, it was in exactly the same location, occupying and maintaining exactly the same real and intellectual properties, employing the same persons in the same positions, performing the same duties and in all other respects operating in the exact same way and carrying out the same purposes and instructions as NSA1.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

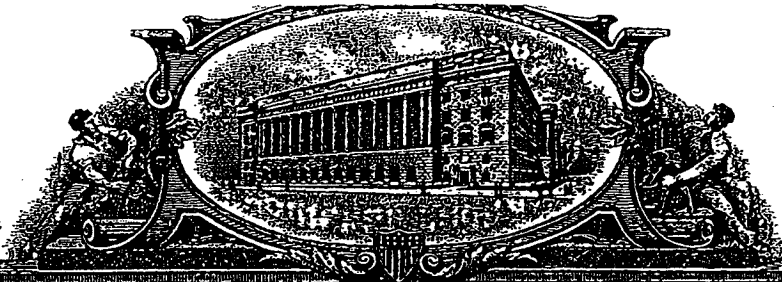

same thereon. The English translation of the Arabic symbol shown on the drawing means "The Greatest Name".

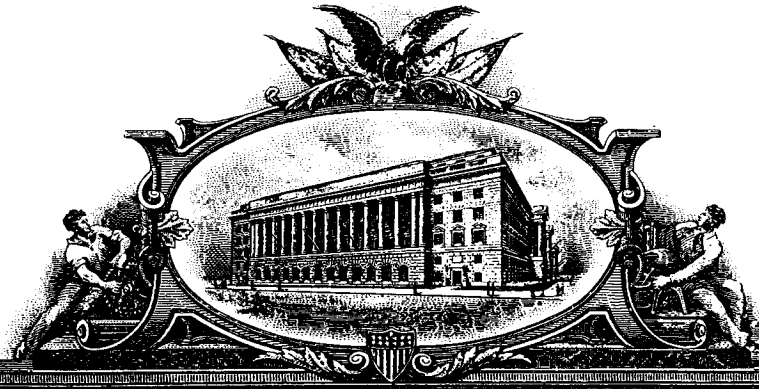

A literal translation of the term "Bahá'í" means "a follower of Baháullah" the founder of the religion.

The present applicant is a common law corporation which does not operate under the laws of any particular State of the United States, but is recognized as a religious body by the Treasury Department of the United States and the declaration of trust has been certified to by the State Department.

The trade-mark was first used in 1900, and first used in commerce among the several States which may lawfully be regulated by Congress in 1900.

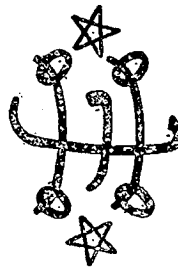

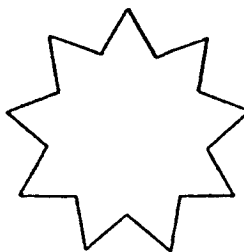
