P. 30(b)(6), will take the deposition of Provisional National Baha'i Council ("PNBC") by oral examination of witness(es) designated by PNBC to testify on its behalf concerning the subjects listed in Attachment A. PNBC shall designate one or more officers, directors, managing agents, or other persons who consent to testify on its behalf as to matters known or reasonably available to PNBC.



The deposition will be taken before an officer authorized to administer oaths at the offices of Bean & Associates, 500 Marquette NW, Suite 280, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87102, or at such other time and place as may be mutually agreed upon, and will continue from day to day until completed, with such adjournments as to time and place as may be necessary. The testimony will be recorded by stenographic and sound-and-visual (videotaping) means.

ATTACHMENT A

Provisional National Baha'i Council ("PNBC") refers to the New Mexico corporation of the same name that is doing business as the Orthodox Baha'i Faith ("OBF") and includes the organization's past and present incorporators, officers, directors, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them or any person operating on its behalf.

The examination of Provisional National Baha'i Council will take place on the following topics or items:

1. Facts indicating that PNBC is bound by the 1966 Judgment in Civil Action No. 64 C 1878.
2. Facts indicating that PNBC has violated the terms of the 1966 Judgment in Civil Action No. 64 C 1878, the nature and extent of such violations, if any, and the identities of all PNBC representatives that may be responsible for the violations.
3. PNBC's contacts and ties to Illinois, including but not limited to, the number of members in Illinois, whether PNBC has attended any events in Illinois, the amount of money raised from Illinois, and whether PNBC has had contact via the Internet with Illinois residents.
4. The identities of all officers, directors, agents, servants, employees, attorneys and all other persons affiliated with PNBC from the inception of PNBC and its predecessors in interest until the present date.
5. The identities and roles of all current officers, directors and members of PNBC.
6. Whether any of the persons in any way affiliated with PNBC from the inception of PNBC and its predecessors in interest until the present date were previously involved with counter-defendant National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of the United States of America Under the Hereditary Guardianship, Inc. ("Remy Corporation") and, if so, their identities.
7. The identities of all persons involved with the Web sites located at domain names: www.rt66.com/~obfusa.com; www.bahai-guardian.com; www.truebahai.com; www.orthodoxbahai.com; and any affiliated Web sites, as well as the extent and nature of the involvement of those persons.
8. The creation, formation, organization, management or operation of PNBC and its predecessors in interest.
9. The succession of Guardians to what PNBC refers to as the Baha'i Faith.
10. PNBC's members' backgrounds and histories with the PNBC and the Remy Corporation.

11. PNBC's views regarding Joel B. Marangella's role in what PNBC refers to as the Baha'i Faith.
12. The PNBC's relationship with and to the OBF and any other OBF administrative entities.
13. Joel B. Marangella's communications and association with Mason Remy.
14. Communications between PNBC's members and OBF members relating to issues of privity and violation of the 1966 Judgment from the date of the 1966 judgment to the present.
15. PNBC's corporate meetings and minutes as they relate to the matters of privity, violation and personal jurisdiction.
16. All documents produced by the named parties in this contempt proceeding.
17. Evidence of actual consumer confusion caused by PNBC's actions.
18. PNBC's defenses to the charge of contempt of the 1966 Judgment in Civil Action No. 64 C 1878.
19. PNBC's and its predecessors in interest's articles of incorporation, by-laws and annual reports.
20. PNBC's responses to NSA's written discovery requests
21. PNBC's response to NSA's Motion for a Rule to Show Cause Why The Remyites Should Not Be Held In Contempt.


